
Dear Bob and Ling:

Please accept my sincerest apologies for any personal and corporate pain caused as a result of the allegations made in my lawsuit filed by my attorneys. Although my attorneys filed this lawsuit to advance my interests, the subsequent and extensive discovery that was conducted demonstrated that the information provided to me by others that led to the allegations was not warranted and not supported by the evidence.
